

TRASH ROOM DO'S & DON'TS— WHAT GOES WHERE?

DOWN THE TRASH CHUTE

- Food and Kitchen Waste
- Used Diapers and Similar Personal Items
- Plastic Bags
- Plastic Foam (Packing Peanuts or Styrofoam)

IMPORTANT:

- **NO GLASS** may be disposed of down the trash chute.
- **All items placed down the chute must be in securely tied bags.**

IN THE GREEN RECYCLING CONTAINER

- EMPTY Steel, Tin & Aluminum Cans
- EMPTY Plastic Bottles & Containers
- EMPTY Glass Bottles & Jars
- EMPTY Cardboard Dairy & Juice Containers
- FLATTENED Cardboard & Paperboard Boxes (Please break down boxes before putting them in the green container.)
- Mixed Paper (Books, Magazines, Newspapers, etc.)
- Paper Cups, Towels, Tissues or Napkins
- Plastic Utensils

PLEASE NOTE:

- **Items placed in the green recycling container:**
 - **May be loose or in paper bags.**
 - **May *not* be bagged in plastic bags.**
- **Our recycler fines for prohibited items that are placed in the recycling container. Biggest offenders: Food (stray or in containers). Plastic Bags.**

ON THE TRASH ROOM FLOOR: EVERYTHING ELSE

- Furniture
- Decorative Accessories (Lamps, Vases, etc.)
- Rugs
- Bedding, Curtains
- Clothing
- Electronics
- Other Household Items (e.g., Ceramics, Dishware, Glassware)
- Wire and Plastic Clothes Hangers
- ALL OTHER ITEMS

PLEASE NOTE: Items placed on the floor may be bagged or loose.
